

# Migration studies program

## Semester 1

### In-depth Thematic study UE-3

- Social Sciences and Migrations 5 ECTS: the 2022/2023 course will be under the responsibility of Philippe Rygiel, with the participation of Laurence Roulleau-Berger, director of research at the CNRS (sociology), Sophie Hatte, lecturer at the ENS de Lyon and Mathieu Couttenier, professor of economics at the ENS de Lyon. Its function will be to present the way in which the social sciences define and capture international migration by focusing on presenting the points currently under debate within the different disciplinary traditions.
- Politics and Policy of Migrations 5 ECTS: the 2022/2023 course will be taught by Yasmine Bouagga, researcher at the CNRS. Its theme will be forced migration.

### Methodological in-depth studies UE-3A

- Time and Places of Migrations 4 ECTS: the 2022/2023 course will be taught by Philippe Rygiel, professor of history at ENS de Lyon, it is titled "Defining and counting migrants. The quantification of international migrations from the statistical congresses of the 19th century to the birth of the Migration data portal."
- Research workshop/ Gathering data collecting evidence on migrations 5 ECTS. A choice will be offered among the research programs currently open, if the health constraints are strong, students will be invited to participate in the Turkey-France International student workshop mobility: management of flows, paths and experiences, coordinated by Marie Vogel, lecturer at ENS de Lyon, which enables remote participation.
