



How to re-apply for a PhD: the deadline is set on November 15th 2023

The following steps are required for your re-enrollment at the ENS de Lyon:

1 - CVEC:

As part of your re-enrollment, you have to pay a contribution of 100 euros for your CVEC (Contribution Vie Etudiante et Campus) to the CROUS at https://cvec.etudiant.gouv.fr/?locale=en and send back the certificate of the CVEC to Bureau du 3eme cycle.

NB. If you are in 2023-24 in an international dual PhD <u>abroad</u>, you are <u>exempted</u> from CVEC fees; BUT you have to provide the exemption certificate.

2 - ADUM:

You must submit your re-enrollment file on the doctoral school platform: "ADUM".

3- Bureau du 3ème cycle ENS de Lyon :

- ▶ If you plan on defending your thesis between October 1st and December 31st 2023*? you ought to:
 - Re-enroll academically first ; do not forget to add your PST fully completed and signed by your thesis supervisor.
 - You will be exempted from your tuition fees and CVEC (*only between those dates).
- > Starting from your fourth year? you will need to renew your proof of financial support.
- If you plan to suspend your research, make sure to fill the caesura year request whilst also still following the instructions regarding the re-enrollment procedure.
