How to enroll for the Workshop

To participate in the Workshop, please fill-in and return this pre-registration form as a file attachment to the email address FlowerWorkshop2019@ens-lyon.fr, as soon as possible, and in any case not later than 15th March. Please note that the number of participants will be limited to keep the Workshop close to an optimum size (100-130 participants) and also because the available accommodation is limited. The organizers therefore reserve the right to refuse registration if too many applications are received. So please send in your pre- registration form as soon as possible to avoid disappointment! Presentation formats

Each themed session will include **invited talks** (please see list of confirmed speakers at: <http://www.ens-lyon.fr/RDP/FlowerWorkshop2019/>), **talks selected** from the abstracts, and also “**flash oral presentations**”. Participants selected to present flash oral presentations will give a brief talk (max 4 min and 3 PP slides) in the appropriate oral session for their subject, and also present a poster, giving fuller details of the same work, in a traditional poster session. Participants may also if they prefer present a poster without giving a flash oral presentation. Please select your preferred presentation format on this pre- registration form (following pages). Full oral and flash oral/poster presentations will be chosen from the abstracts by the Scientific Committee (see timetable, below).
