






Covid: how to be vaccinated?

Where to get vaccinated?

You can be vaccinated by a doctor, pharmacist, a doctor, pharmacist, nurse, midwife at a vaccination center or by a mobile team.



In practice

The vaccine is free.

If you are not covered by the Social Security, AME or don't have a Carte Vitale, you can still be vaccinated.

Keep the document you will be given. It will be helpful to show you have been vaccinated (Passe sanitaire).






Before vaccination

You can ask any questions to the health professional. They will check that the vaccine has been recommanded for you.

Number of injections?

There are different vaccines. All are effective.



At the start, usually 2 injections are needed, Then 1 extra booster injection is needed,
5 months later, for everyone
18 years old and over.

After vaccinated



The vaccine can cause a sore arm, headache or fever. These will only last for 1 to 2 days.
