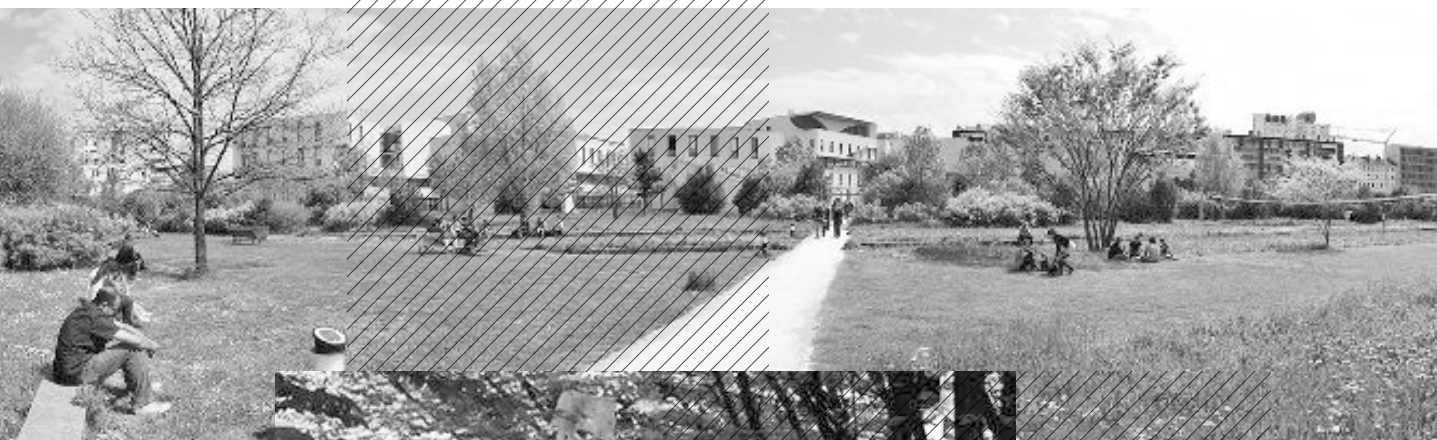

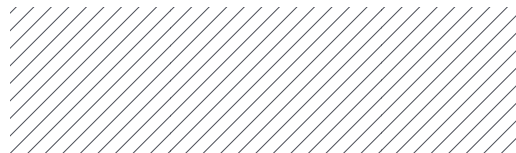

ENS DE LYON, STUDY FOR RESEARCH

ENS de Lyon is an elite French public institution that trains professors, researchers, senior civil servants as well as business and political leaders. Students choose their courses and split their time between training and research in Sciences and Humanities. Built on the tradition of ENS de Fontenay and Saint-Cloud, founded in 1880, ENS de Lyon also focuses on educational research. It is a symbol of French republican meritocracy and it remains committed today to disseminating knowledge to the widest audience and to promoting equal opportunity.

ENS de Lyon is part of Université de Lyon and supports quality research that has earned it a Fields medal (Cédric VILLANI, 2010) and many CNRS medals. It encourages interdisciplinary studies to foster a better understanding of complex contemporary issues.





LYON, AN IDEAL CITY FOR STUDENTS

Congratulations! You have chosen Lyon, France's second biggest city in terms of student population, with 130,000 students including 15,000 international students. EQUALITY AND NON-DISCRIMINATION

PREVENTION OF GENDER-BASED AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE

REPORTING INCIDENTS AND HELPLINE

For acts that may amount to gender or sexual discrimination, harassment or violence, a special procedure has been set up at ENS de Lyon. This procedure does not require you to have filed a formal legal complaint. It is conducted completely independently of any other legal action taken at a criminal level and is based on 4 principles:

- distinct stages involving key players who are independent from each other.
- a counselling team to listen actively to the person who has reported the case in a caring, objective and unprejudiced manner
- action carried out in agreement with the person who reported the case.
- procedures subject to confidentiality by the various stakeholders involved.

If you are a victim or witness of gender-based, LGBTphobia or sexual violence or any form of discrimination or harassment, you are invited to report it using:

- a dedicated email address: signalement.violences.discriminations@ens-lyon.fr
- an anonymous form (in French and English) available on the School's website, under the headings "About us > Our commitments > Fight against discrimination and violence".

The Equality advisors, the Equality and non-discrimination officer and the occupational psychologist are the only ones with access to this report. They will respond within a week to fifteen days maximum (except during school holidays or when the School's offices are closed).

If the person who filed the report wishes to continue the process, an appointment will be set up with two helpline advisors including a member of the Equality Team: (Equality Team Officer and / or Equality Officer) or the occupational psychologist or, possibly, a member of the Medical Health Service (doctor or nurse). In agreement with the person being listened to, this information is then given to the Action Unit, which meets every fortnight, and, after studying the situation, draws up recommendations and forwards them to the Registry Office. In agreement with **the person who reported the incident**, these measures are initiated after **a decision by the Governing Board**.

THE EQUALITY PLAN

Mobilized since 2013 in favor of professional gender diversity and equality, the ENS de Lyon has renewed its commitments within the framework of a second Action Plan for Professional Equality between Women and Men, for the period 2024-2026. This action plan was presented to the governing bodies and approved by the Administrative Board on December 12, 2024.

The action plan for professional equality 2024-2026 comprises 114 actions divided into 7 axes:

1. Governance, management and monitoring of the professional equality policy;
2. Evaluation, prevention and treatment of pay gaps between women and men;
3. Ensuring equal access to jobs and professional responsibilities;
4. Balancing private and professional life and supporting parenthood;
5. Quality of life at work, working conditions and occupational health from a gender perspective;
6. Equality issues in the quality of student life;
7. Prevention and handling of reports of discrimination, moral harassment, sexist and sexual violence and LGBT+phobia.

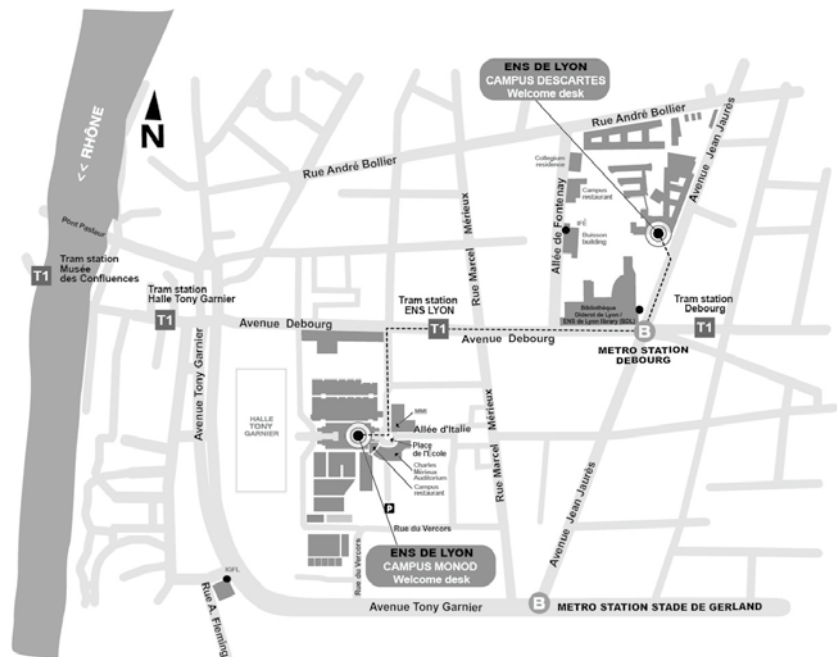

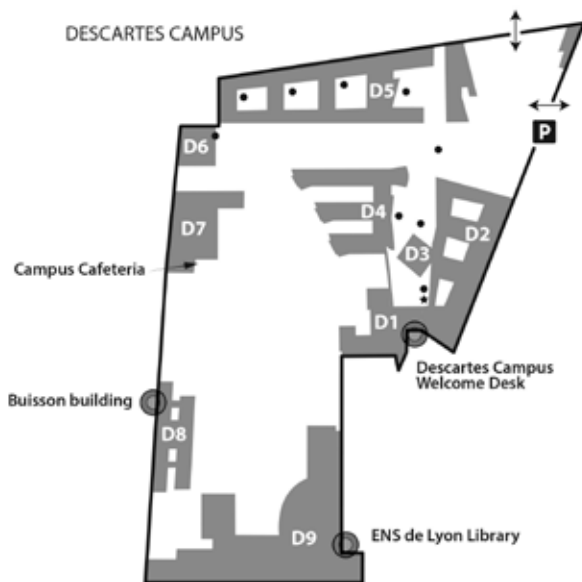

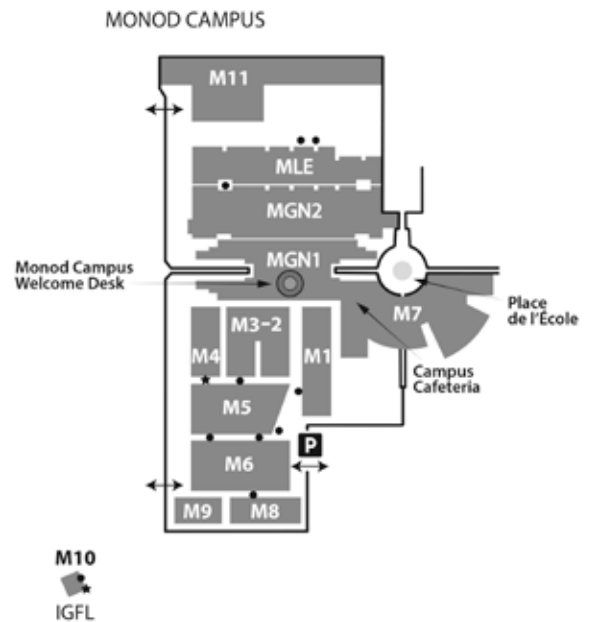

NOISE DISTURBANCE

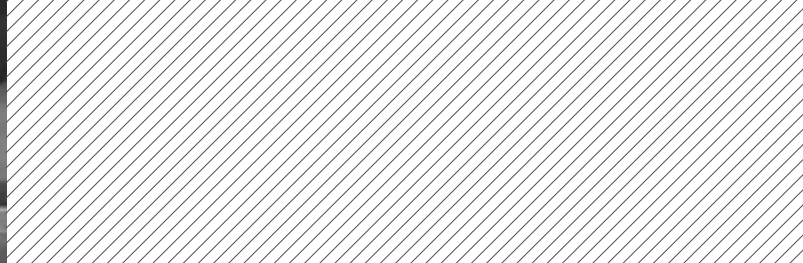

ENS DE LYON IS ECO-FRIENDLY!

ENS de Lyon has recently developed eco-friendly solutions to help protect the environment while improving life on campus. Sorting bins and compost bins are at your disposal in the residences on both sites (contact ENvertS to request a compost bucket). To encourage soft mobility, there are several bicycle shelters on site. On a broader level, the School has implemented solutions to reduce its digital pollution, save energy flows and reduce its carbon footprint. A special Sustainable Development program has been set up since 2020 to identify and support the activities and initiatives carried out at ENS de Lyon.

To meet the challenges of the ecological transition and embed them in daily practices, the ENS de Lyon adopted a Sustainable Development and Social Responsibility Master Plan in 2025. Covering the period 2025-2028, it contains all the ecological transition and social responsibility objectives that the School has set for its various activities.





TRANSPORTATION

TICKETS AND PASSES

At each tram stop and subway station, you will find an automatic ticket machine where you can buy tickets and renew your TCL card.

How to create your TCL transportation card (student price)?

Vélo'v is a bicycle sharing system run by the city of Lyon.

You can borrow bicycles anywhere, anytime at one of the 350 stations spread across Lyon and Villeurbanne.

Annual subscriptions start from €31 (adults) or €16,50 (below 25 years old). For every journey, they start charging you from the 31st minute (first 30 minutes are free).

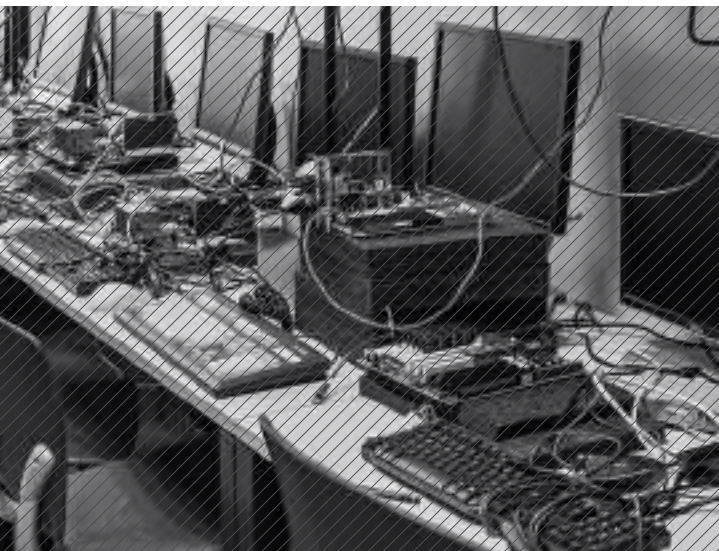
1. To avoid password theft, create a strong authentication. Discover all the steps on: <https://intranet.ens-lyon.fr/documentation/authentication-forte>
2. Don't forget to write down your backup codes! They'll come in handy if you lose your phone: "Back-up codes" link in ENT or <https://codesecours.ens-lyon.fr>
3. Beware of phishing and be careful of fake e-mails.
4. Also beware of attachments that may contain viruses.
5. Store your data in a backed-up space.
6. Never reuse the password "ENS de Lyon" on another site.
7. Never install pirated software or software you don't know the source of.
8. Don't save passwords in your browser, as they can easily be stolen. Instead, use the password manager : <https://intranet.ens-lyon.fr/documentation/gestionnaire-de-mot-de-passe>

ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

If you are also an administrator of your computer.

8. Use the antivirus provided by ENS de Lyon on your professional computer.

AT ENS DE LYON

FOOD AND CATERING

The campus features 2 student restaurants managed by the CROUS, one on each site, with balanced menus at a low price for lunch time (from 11:30am to 2pm) and 1 cafeteria (Monod campus, from 8am to 3pm). They are closed on Saturdays and Sundays and during Christmas and summer holidays.

ON THE MENU AT OUR SCHOOL RESTAURANT

The full menu (6 points) consists of a wide choice of starters, main courses, cheeses and desserts. Our chefs cook on site with local products, that are organic, fresh, with sustainably farmed meat and fish. With your container, you can take a takeaway menu for the evening, consisting of a dish and 2 desserts (yoghurt or fruit). The full menu rate is priced at 6 points €3.30 and €1 for scholarship students (rate 2024-2025).

ON THE MENU AT OUR CAFETERIA

On site or to take away adapted to your budget, you can have your breakfast, your lunch or your takeaway meal for the evening, along with salads, sandwiches, paninis, hot dishes, cookies, pastries, and drinks.

The student menu rate for a sandwich, a dairy product and a dessert: €3.30 and €1 for scholarship students (rate 2024-2025).

The Crous de Lyon no longer provides free disposable containers for the sale of drinks or takeaway dishes in all its structures. Remember to bring your mug or water bottle for drinks as well as your cutlery, bento and bag for takeaway meals. If necessary, you can buy reusable or disposable containers on site (cup, cutlery, bag... from €0.10 to €6.50).



PAYMENT METHOD: IZLY CONTACTLESS PAYMENT IN ALL CATERING FACILITIES

Payment in Crous restaurants and cafeterias is made exclusively with an activated and topped up Izly account. Once your account has been topped up, you pay for your meals with your student card (used as a payment card) or with the Izly app on your smartphone.

ENS DE LYON LIBRARY

The Diderot de Lyon Library contributes to the institution's training and research activities. It is responsible for documentation and cultural, scientific and technical activities. As a study and research library, it offers multidisciplinary documentation and provides access to a wide range of online documentation (magazines, e-books, heritage documents).

On the Descartes campus (D9 building) are all the collections of Literature, Languages, Philosophy, Humanities and Social Sciences, collections specialized in education, heritage collections. The library is also equipped with a video library and a map library. The collections of the research laboratories in Literature and Humanities are located at the Research Documentation Center (CDR, Research building).

On the Monod campus (1st floor, near the Teaching section), you will find books on STEM(Mathematics, Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Earth Sciences).

On the website, you'll have access to the catalog, electronic resources and a presentation of all the library's services. You can also access national and international online press (Europresse, Mediapart, PressReader).

The library can help you with your documentary research, train you in the use of electronic resources or the management of bibliographic references, and offers an interlibrary loan service. It is possible to print, photocopy and scan on site, as well as to reserve work rooms for individuals or groups.

LEAVE FOR MENSTRUAL DISORDERS

One of the key measures in the new action plan for professional equality is the introduction of a menstrual leave scheme. This measure is aimed at all menstruating students enrolled at ENS de Lyon. All menstrual disorders causing difficulties or incapacity to complete studies are taken into account.

15 days of absence are authorized for each academic year. No supporting documents are required: simply fill in a form and hand it in to your school administrator, while notifying your teacher of your absence from class (without having to specify the reason).

THE RISKS OF ALCOHOL

Be aware of the dangers of alcohol.

Whether partying or relaxing in the evening, alcohol consumption increases the risk of illness in adulthood and high-level alcohol consumption can be a gateway to later dependence. The short-term risks of alcohol abuse are also significant: lack of concentration and energy, poor quality sleep, loss of consciousness, violence either as a victim and/or perpetrator, non-consensual sex or road accidents; alcohol is responsible for 25% of deaths among 15–34-year-olds and it is the second leading cause of preventable death, just after tobacco.

If you have any questions or concerns about your alcohol consumption, take an appointment with the student health service.

CULTURAL FACILITIES

At ENS de Lyon, there are cultural activities for everyone (open to all staff and students as well as the general public and often free) created by student associations, training departments and research laboratories.

All the arts are present throughout the campus, with numerous facilities, associations, staff and external partners to promote artistic events. Some of the different places to produce and discover artistic creations are:

- **the Artemisia Gallery** that mainly hosts art exhibitions. It is equipped with the best equipment to present artwork (lighting, sound, etc.);
- **the Kantor Theater** is a theater-school that reflects the specificity of ENS de Lyon by combining research and training. It hosts the activities of the Arts section (master class, dramaturgy workshops, etc.), participates in the dissemination of scientific activities (film screenings, seminars, etc.) and provides a space for creation and communication for students, within associations (ENScène, Champ Libre) and institutional partnerships with other institutions (CNSMD, Opéra de Lyon...). The theater's program, open to everyone, is established by a commission based on a biannual call for projects (in May and November);
- **two workshops** on the Descartes campus for **visual arts and photography**. They are accessible to all students through ENplaStik! which organizes courses and coordinates the use of the film development laboratory;
- **the hall of the Diderot de Lyon Library** and the room **La Parenthese** are the place for numerous thematic exhibitions and meetings with writers and researchers;
- other spaces such as the **Dutilleux Hall** (D2.008, Descartes campus), the **Félix Pécaut forum** (Descartes campus), **the Verrière** (open only to the ENS community) in front of the library (Monod campus) can also accommodate concerts, exhibitions or other forms of artistic expression.

ENS de Lyon also has a TV studio and a recording studio run by ENS Media.
